Certificate in Teaching English as a Foreign Language

CertTEFL from EDI

The EDI CertTEFL is a Level 4 qualification (UK NQF equivalent) designed for people who have little or no experience of teaching English as a foreign language (EFL) but who wish to embark on a career as an EFL teacher.

The EDI Cert TEFL is a highly practical course designed to provide candidates with the initial skills they need for teaching English to adult students of other languages.

Achievement of EDI CertTEFL will confirm that candidates:

- have a good understanding of the essential aspects of the EFL teacher's role
- can organize and manage effective learning
- have developed professionally through ongoing reflection and evaluation

Accreditation

The EDI CertTEFL qualification is accredited by the UK regulatory authority.

Aims

The aims of the EDI CertTEFL qualification are to enable the learner to:

- evaluate the communicative needs of classes of speakers of other languages
- meet these needs through effective teaching
- evaluate how effectively they are meeting these needs

When?

The total of 120hrs of the course will be divided into 2 two-week sessions:

1. 28 June - 9 July 2010
2. 30 August - 10 September 2010

How?

The total of 120hrs includes direct contact hours as well as other time when candidate's work is being supervised by the course teachers. Candidates are also expected to complete an appropriate amount of self-directed study, which may include background reading, written assignments and other homework assignments. Candidates must also complete 6hrs of observed and assessed teaching practice and 4hrs of teaching observation.

Unit Structure

The EDI CertTEFL has a unitised structure consisting of six mandatory units.

- Unit 1: Teaching and learning in a EFL context
- Unit 2: Developing teaching skills and managing the learning environment
- Unit 3: Teaching language
- Unit 4: Teaching language skills
- Unit 5: Planning and evaluation
- Unit 6: Assessment of learners

The programme includes the following methods and strategies:

- Presentation/demonstration
- Group work
- Investigation/report/shared experience
- Workshop activity e.g. preparing sessions
- Investigation/resource based learning followed by group discussions
- Sub-group activities
- Observation of a teacher teaching or trainer training
- Self-evaluation/evaluation with mentor

Assessment

The EDI CertTEFL is assessed via a combination of teaching practice, teacher observation and written assignments. Assessment consists of :

- observation of experienced teachers within the learning environment
- delivery of monitored teaching practice classess
- demonstration of learning through written assignments
