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1) PRESENTATION

The International Workshop on the Contemporary City, presented by **Cultura Sostenibile,** is a three day intensive programme on rethinking the lived city.

Utilizing literature, film and research on the implementation of sustainability principles, such as the Victorian Eco-Innovation Lab's *eco-acupuncture* model, the workshop aims to explore the processes of envisioning, and their relevance to the transformation of a lived place.

The workshop also aims to inspire the kind of awareness, thinking and skills that might be made available in redesigning the core elements of the livable city

You will be involved in collective, hands-on work designing a visual walk through the city, which might be Siracusa or any another city.

Your participation is of value in fulfilling the workshop objectives of broadening horizons, and providing a space of encounter and exchange.

a) PROGRAMME

Cities may be invisible, future projections of our dreams; but they are also real. We are surrounded by the visible city – the contemporary city. How do we relate to the city as it transforms? As a living place and a place that is lived, the city is the prerogative of its inhabitants –

my place. Discovering our city we uncover where it is most dynamic, beautiful and livable – its captured characteristics. In the city, architecture, infrastructure, technology and urban planning coincide with culture and governance; but what visioning binds their interrelations? From literature to film, to the latest research on regenerating the city as a locus of sustainable living, we explore, invent, visualise and design; all this in one of the most beautiful cities in the world.

4) LOCATION & TRAVEL

j) LOCATION

The workshop will take place in the city of Siracusa, located in the south-eastern part of the island of Sicily, Italy. The workshop space is located in a small Villa adjacent to the Catacombs/Ancient Greek Acqueducts of Siracusa. In the afternoon we will be meeting in Ortigia, the historic part of Siracusa, situated on a small island connected to the mainland by three bridges.

k) HOW TO GET TO SIRACUSA

The nearest airport is Catania, connected to most European and Italian cities. Catania Airport is approximately 60km from Siracusa. Coaches depart regularly from the airport for Siracusa (Interbus / Azienda Siciliana Trasporti).

Getting around Ortigia is easy since most places are within walking distance. The workshop space is located in via Augusto von Platen, which is in the vicinity of the Paolo Orsi Museum and the Madonna delle Lacrime. You can get from Ortigia to via von Platen by foot (a 20-30 minute walk), bicycle, bus or taxi.
